## Urban Areas.

POR the purposes of population statistics, vital statistics, &c., metropolitan areas were delineated in 1916 at each of the four chief centres, and suburban areas at nine of the secondary centres. The names "metropolitan area" and "suburban area" are now replaced by the uniform title of "urban area."
