##### RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and the Acts (if any) amending the same respectively, the Marton Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of two thousand pounds (£2,000), authorized to be raised by the said Marton Borough Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of extensions to the borough waterworks scheme, the said Marton Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one farthing in the pound sterling upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all the rateable property within the Borough of Marton; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the first days of December and June in each year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

#### POHANGINA COUNTY COUNCIL.

##### RESOLUTION STRIKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and amendments thereto, and all other Acts in that behalf enabling, the Pohangina County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments of principal and interest and also the other charges on a loan of £700 (the cost of raising the loan is to be paid out of the money so raised), authorized to be raised by the Pohangina County Council, under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and amendments thereto, and the Housing Act, 1919, for erecting a worker's dwelling for the use of the Coal Creek Riding roadman, the Pohangina County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 1/20th of a penny in the pound on the capital rateable value of all the rateable property in the Coal Creek Riding, with the exception of Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11A, 12A, Block II, Pohangina Survey District, and Section 5, Block VII, and Section 34, Block VI, Pohangina Survey District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the first day of April and the first day of October in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 36½ years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
