WAIMARINO COUNTY COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Waimarino County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of principal and interest and also the other charges on a loan of £250, authorized to be raised by the Waimarino County Council, under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for the purpose of trimming, forming, and metalling the Pakihi Road from the Mangawhero River Bridge to the northern boundary of the Tawhito-Ariki Block Run 25 Part 2, the said Waimarino County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one penny (1d.) in the pound sterling upon the rateable (unimproved) value of all rateable property of
