

455, and 456 to Maungakawa; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 456, 457, 458, 459, 460, 461, and 495 to the Mangapiko Valley Road, and south-easterly along that road fronting or passing through Sections 495, 498, 295, 294, 293, 292, 291, 290, 289, 288, 283, 208A, 254, 222, 225, and 233 to the southernmost corner of the last-named section; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of said Section 233 to the Mangapiko Stream, and down that stream to the boundary of the Mangawara Drainage District, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 1919, page 564; thence north-westerly along that boundary to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

MANGAWARA DRAINAGE DISTRICT.

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the north-eastern corner of Section 366, Taupiri Parish, and proceeding thence along the shore of the Waikare Lake to the north-eastern corner of Section 191; thence along the north-eastern boundary of that section and the southern boundary of Section 2, Block V, Hapuakohe Survey District, to the south-eastern corner of said Section 2, and proceeding thence northerly along a road forming the eastern boundary of said Section 2, and easterly along a road forming the southern boundary of Section 3; thence along the southern and eastern boundaries of Small Grazing-run 18 to the westernmost corner of Lot 5 of Section 279, Whangamarino Parish, along the north-western boundary of said Lot 5 to the western boundary of Section 471; thence southerly along that boundary and north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of Sections 472, 448, 449, 450, 451, 452, 453, and 454; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 454, 455, and 456 to Maungakawa; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 456, 457, 458, 459, 460, 461, and 495 to the Mangapiko Valley Road, and south-easterly along that road fronting or passing through Sections 495, 498, 295, 294, 293, 292, 291, 290, 289, 288, 283, 208A, 254, 222, 225, and 233 to the southernmost corner of the last-named section; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of said Section 233 to the Mataluru Stream, and down that stream to the road forming the western boundary of Section 241; along that road and the road running south-easterly fronting Sections 197, 199, part 465, 202, 204, 206, and part 465 to Section 324; along the road forming the western boundary of Section 324; along the western and southern boundaries of Section 331 to the western boundary of Section 342 to its southernmost corner; thence along the road forming the south-eastern boundary of that section, and the road forming the south-western boundary of Section 467 to the Mangawara Stream; thence towards the south generally by that stream to the road at the north-western corner of Section 151 in Block XIII of the said survey district; thence towards the west generally along that road running northward past Sections 188, 189, 190, 192, and 193, and the road along the northern boundaries of Sections 193, 194, and 196, along the western boundary of Section 196 to its south-western corner, and thence along a right line to Trig. Station Pukemore No. 676A; thence along a right line to the road at the south-eastern corner of Section 390, Taupiri Parish; along that road to the northern boundary of Block XII, Rangiriri Survey District; thence due east to the road near the southernmost corner of Section 348, along that road to and along the south-western boundary of the said Section 348 to the junction of roads at the easternmost corner of Section 349 in Block V, Hapuakohe Survey District; thence by a right line to the junction of roads at the westernmost corner of Section 280 in Block V, Hapuakohe Survey District; thence by the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 348 and 366, to the place of commencement.

Amending Regulations under the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of June, 1921.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby amend, in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereto, the regu-

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tions under the said Act made on the twentieth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the twenty-second day of August, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen.

SCHEDULE.

CLAUSE 20 of the said regulations is hereby further amended by adding to subclause (d) thereof the following proviso:—

"Provided that advances made under subclause (c) for buildings on rural holdings not exceeding in area 21 acres may be made by way of mortgage in the Form No. 10 in the First Schedule, or as near thereto as may be necessary, and shall be repayable by half-yearly or monthly instalments over a period of twenty-five years and a half. Every instalment shall consist partly of interest and partly of principal, and shall be calculated at the rate of 7 per centum per annum on the amount of the advance, and shall be applied towards payment of interest and principal in the proportions set out respecting the appropriate payment in the Second Schedule hereto. Form No. 10 in the First Schedule hereto shall be altered where necessary to provide for payment by monthly instalments. The decision as to whether moneys advanced shall be secured by way of flat mortgage or by instalment mortgage, and in the latter case whether such moneys shall be repayable by half-yearly or monthly instalments, shall be at the discretion of the Minister."
