ABSTRACT OF CONDITIONS OF LEASE.

1. Possession will be given on day of sale.
2. A term of twenty-one years from 1st January, 1922.
3. At end of term lease to be submitted at auction, weighted with valuation for improvements payable by incoming tenant.
4. A half-year's rent at the rate offered, and rent for the broken period between the date of sale and 31st December, 1921, lease and registration fees (£2 2s.), stamp duty, and valuation for improvements, to be paid on the fall of the hammer.
5. No assignment, sublease, mortgage, or other disposition without consent of Land Board.
