

SCALES FOR GENERAL DIVISION.

Where increments of less than £10 are provided, double increments may be granted in special cases.

In the column "Annual Increments" the normal annual increment is shown. The last increment shall, where necessary, be such lesser sum as will enable the maximum to be attained, and not exceeded.
