Now, therefore, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Acts aforesaid, do hereby set apart the portion of the secondaryeducation endowment described in the Schedule hereto as an addition to a site for a boys' high school.
