PATEA COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Patea County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £1,000, authorized to be raised by the Patea County Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for metalling Lower Ball Road, the said Patea County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one halfpenny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Lower Ball Road Special Rating Area within the following boundaries: Commencing at the intersection of the Ball Road with the main South Road; thence by the north and north-western boundaries of Section 515; thence by the south boundary of Sections 516 and 525; thence by the Mangaroa Stream to its junction with the Kaikura Lake; thence by north-west boundary of Section 423, the Manawapou Road, and the south boundary of Section 424 to the Ball Road; thence by the Ball Road and Manawapou Road and the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 459, 457, and 455; thence in a right line to the main South Road, and by the main South Road to the commencing-point.

And that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being for a period of 36½ years, or until such loan is fully paid off.
