HIKAWERA ROAD LOA, £500.—RESOLUTION LEVYING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and amendments thereto, the Featherston County Council hereby resolves as follows:—
