ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of October, 1921.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by section seventeen of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1912, it is enacted that the Governor-General may by Order in Council, on the recommendation of the Native Land Court, declare any Native to be a European :

And whereas Sarah Savage, *alias* Te Rangi Paiia, *alias* Hera Haweti, *alias* Hera Rangipaia, of Matata, being a Native within the meaning of the Native Land Act, 1909, applied in the prescribed form for a recommendation of the Court that she might be declared a European : And whereas the said Court, having duly inquired into the said application, has recommended that an Order in Council be issued declaring the said Sarah Savage, *alias* Te Rangi Paiia, *alias* Hera Haweti, *alias* Hera Rangipaia, to be a European : And whereas it is expedient that such declaration should be made :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authority conferred on him by section seventeen of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1912, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby declare the said Sarah Savage, *alias* Te Rangi Paiia, *alias* Hera Haweti, *alias* Hera Rangipaia, to be a European.
