A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1908.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Land Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the sixteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 77, of the eighteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, proclaiming land as a road, and road closed, in Blocks XI, XII, XV, and XVI, Opuha Survey District, Mackenzie County, by substituting the area 35.9 perches for the area 31.8 perches in the second item of the First Schedule to the said Proclamation, and by substituting the area 31.8 perches for the area 35.9 perches in the second item of the Second Schedule to the said Proclamation.
