BY virtue of the powers vested in us by law, we, the undersigned Judges of the Supreme Court of New Zealand, do make the following rule and regulation under the Law Practitioners Act, 1908, to come into force on and after the 1st day of November, 1921, that is to say:

Any candidate for admission as a solicitor shall be deemed to have passed the examination in general knowledge required.

to have passed the examination in general knowledge required to be passed by candidates for admission as solicitors if he shall have passed the Matriculation Examination of any university or college the standard of whose Matriculation Examination is, in the opinion of the Chancellor of the New Zealand University, as high as the standard required for Matriculation in the University of New Zealand, and if such candidate shall have passed in Latin as one of the subjects of such Matriculation Examination.
