IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that the portion of road described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of this Order in Council, become a county road.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that portion of road in the North Auckland Land District, Otamatea County, known as the Burch's to Wairere Road (Specks to Lindquists portion), commencing at a point about five chains west of the south-eastern corner of Section 71 S.W., Paparoa Parish, Matakoho Survey District, and proceeding thence generally in a westerly direction, adjoining or passing through the said Section 71 S.W. and Sections 70 N.E., 70 S.W., Paparoa Parish, and Sections 139E and part 139W, Matakoho Parish, Block XI, Matakoho Survey District, and terminating at a point about five chains south-west of the south-eastern corner of the said Section 139W; being a distance of seventy-eight chains, more or less. subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the northern side of the portion of Ghuznee Street described in the Schedule hereto within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
