A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation made on the twenty-fourth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and published in the *Gazette* of the twenty-ninth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, setting apart Crown land for selection by discharged soldiers, under the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915.
