Notice prohibiting the Sale in the Borough of Gisborne of certain Goods comprised in the Trade of a Tobacconist, under the Shops and Offices Act, 1921–22.

WHEREAS a petition in writing, signed by a majority of the occupiers of all the tobacconists' shops within the Borough of Gisborne has been forwarded to me, desiring that the sale of certain goods comprised in the trade of a tobacconist—namely, cigarettes, tobacco, and cigars—be prohibited during such times as the said shops are required to be closed in pursuance of the Shops and Offices Act,

And whereas, I, George James Anderson, Minister of Labour, am satisfied that the sale of the said goods is com-prised in the trade of a tobacconist in the said district, and

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 33 of the said Act, I do hereby direct that on and after the 15th day of June, 1922, the sale of the said goods in the Borough of Gisborne shall be and is hereby prohibited as follows: With the exception of the working-day that first precedes Christmas Day and with the exception of the working-day that first precedes New Year's Day, on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays after the hour of 5.30 p.m., and on Saturdays after the hour of 9 p.m. Saturdays after the hour of 9 p.m.
