A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the twelfth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 85, of the fourteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, taking land for scenic purposes in Blocks III and IX, Arapawa Survey District, as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being no longer required for the purposes for which it was taken.
