Notice under the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22, prohibiting the Sale in the Borough of Palmerston North of certain Goods comprised in the Trade of a Butcher.

WHEREAS a petition in writing, signed by a majority of the occupiers of all the butchers' shops within the Borough of Palmerston North, has been forwarded to me, desiring that the sale of certain goods comprised in the trade of a butcher—namely, fresh meat—be prohibited during such times as the said shops are required to be closed in pursuance of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22, or of any award:

Dumping Duty on Wooden Doors.

Customs Department,
Wellington, 19th July, 1922.

IT is hereby notified, for public information, that it is intended to immediately levy dumping duty under section 11 of the Customs Amendment Act, 1921, upon imported wooden doors wherever it is found that the selling-price to an importer in New Zealand is less than the current domestic value determined in accordance with the Customs Acts, and where, in addition, such importations would, by reason of their magnitude or otherwise, have an effect prejudicial or injurious to an industry established in New Zealand.
