A PROCLAMATION.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the twentieth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 92, of the twenty-seventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, taking land for scenic purposes in Block X, Waipakura Survey District, as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being no longer required for the purpose for which it was taken.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Swamp Drainage Act, 1915, and the Public Works Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the more effective carrying-out of the drainage or other works in the Hikurangi Drainage Area or for the better disposal of Crown or other land within the said drainage area, and shall vest in His Majesty the King as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I do also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the second day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two.
