That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of three thousand pounds (£3,000), authorized to be raised by the Te Puke Land Drainage Board, under the above-mentioned Act, for making the following works, viz.,—

SPECIAL ORDER AUTHORIZING THE RAISING OF A SPECIAL LOAN.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 6 of the Local Bodies' Finance Act, 1921-22, and section 16 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and all other powers thereto enabling, the Levin Borough Council hereby resolves by special order as follows:—

1. That a special loan of £3,546 be raised for the purpose of paying off the antecedent liability of the said Council as at 31st March, 1922.

2. That in respect of such special loan nine (9) debentures of £354 and one debenture of £360 be issued, such debentures to bear interest at the rate of six pounds ten shillings (£6 10s.) per centum per annum (or such other rate of interest as may be approved by the Governor-General in Council in terms of the Finance Act, 1921).

3. That the currency of the said special loan shall be ten (10) years.

4. That one debenture be redeemed in each year during the currency of such special loan, the first debenture to be
