

MENTAL HOSPITALS DEPARTMENT.

NOTES.—Increases due to attendants and nurses below the rank of Senior are according to scale and subject to qualifying in their respective grades. Where the services of attendants and nurses who have not passed the Junior Examination at the end of their first year, and do not pass this examination until after eighteen months' service, are retained, the first increment of salary will date from the passing of the examination, and subsequent increments from the anniversary thereof.
