

Notice under the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22, prohibiting the Sale in the Borough of Lyttelton of certain Goods comprised in the Trade of a Tobacconist.

WHEREAS a petition in writing, signed by a majority of the occupiers of all the tobacconists' shops within the Borough of Lyttelton has been forwarded to me, desiring that the sale of certain goods comprised in the trade of a tobacconist—namely, cigars, cigarettes, and tobacco—be prohibited during such time as the said shops are required to be closed in pursuance of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22:

And whereas I, George James Anderson, Minister of Labour, am satisfied that the sale of the said goods is comprised in the trade of a tobacconist in the said district, and that the signatures to such petition represent a majority of the occupiers of all the said shops in the said district:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 33 of the said Act, I do hereby direct that on and after the 23rd day of November, 1922, the sale of the said goods in the Borough of Lyttelton shall be and is hereby prohibited as follows: On Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays after the hour of 7 p.m.
