RESOLVED, "That the report of the Lands Committee, brought up on Wednesday, the 26th October, upon the proposal contained in Paper 169, to reserve permanently Section 49, Block XII, Hangarua Survey District, Section 11, Block IV, Wairarapa Survey District, Blocks XIII, XIV, Taringatara Survey District, and Lots 1, 2, and 3 of Allotments 1 and 2, Block VI, Town of Gladstone, be agreed to."
