BOROUGH OF AVONDALE.

Results of Polls on Proposals to raise Loans.

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, I hereby give notice that a poll of ratepayers of the Borough of Avondale was taken on the 28th day of October, 1922, on the proposal of the Avondale Borough Council to borrow a sum of £26,000 for the construction of a main sewer.

The number of votes recorded for the proposal was 173, and the number of votes recorded against the proposal was 346.

I therefore declare that the proposal was rejected.

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, I hereby give notice that a poll of ratepayers of the Borough of Avondale was taken on the 28th day of October, 1922, on the proposal of the Avondale Borough Council to borrow the sum of £6,000 for the acquisition of stone-crusher, road-making plant, purchase of land, and provision of buildings, fire-brigade station, and appliances, and landing-stage at Whau Creek.

The number of votes recorded for the proposal was 319, and the number of votes recorded against the proposal was 207.

I therefore declare that the proposal was carried.
