Warrant vesting the Control of Brucefield Avenue, Kitchener Street, Portion of Bridge Street, Portion of Princes Street, Portion of Jones Street, and Trevors Road in the Ashburton Borough Council, and apportioning the Cost of Maintenance.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and the Public Works Amendment Act, 1910, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby direct that the streets and portions of streets lying along the boundary between the Borough of Ashburton and the Wakanui Road District, and mentioned in the Schedule hereto, shall

on and after the date of the gazettement hereof be under the control of the Ashburton Borough Council; and I do hereby further direct that the cost of constructing or maintaining or lighting or widening or reconstructing the said streets and portions of streets shall be borne by the Ashburton Borough Council and the Wakanui Road Board in the following proportions—viz., the Ashburton Borough Council shall bear fifty per centum of such cost, and the Wakanui Road Board shall bear fifty per centum of such cost respectively; and I do also further direct that any contribution hereby required to be made as aforesaid by the Wakanui Road Board shall be paid from time to time, in the proportion hereinbefore prescribed, out of the funds of the said Road Board, within a period of one month after demand in writing made by or on behalf of the Ashburton Borough Council, and that such payment shall be made from time to time to the Town Clerk, Ashburton, for and on behalf of the Wakanui Road Board.

SCHEDULE.

ALL those streets or portions of streets situated in the Canterbury Land District and lying along the boundary between the Borough of Ashburton and the Wakanui Road District as follows, viz. :—

Brucefield Avenue from the borough boundary to its junction with Kitchener Street.

Kitchener Street from its junction with Brucefield Avenue to its junction with Bridge Street.

Bridge Street from its junction with Kitchener Street to its junction with Princes Street.
