## HAE HAE TE MOANA SCENIC RESERVES.

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District, containing by admeasurement 86 acres, more or less, being Reserve 3883 (in red), (Four Peaks Settlement), situated in Block XV, Four Peaks Survey District. Commencing at the south-eastern corner of Reserve 3884; thence bounded towards the east by Sections 4 and 6, by lines aggregating 4216.7 links; towards the south-west and south generally by the Hae Hae Te Moana River; towards the south-west and north-west by Section 1A, 1337.7 links and 1817.2 links respectively; and again towards the north-west by Reserve 3884, 2662.3 links, to the point of commencement: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.
