**W**HEREAS by section three of the Westland and Nelson Coalfields Administration Act 1877 Amendment Act, 1893, it is, *inter alia*, enacted that the Governor-General, by Order in Council, shall define such portions of the Westport Colliery Reserve, in addition to the portions thereof already set apart for railway purposes by Orders in Council (*Gazettes* of 1876 and 1894, pages 200 and 1394 respectively), as are likely to be required for railway purposes or other public purposes, and shall set apart such further portions for the aforesaid purposes accordingly:
