WHEREAS it is provided by section three of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918, that any area or areas of land may be constituted an electric-power district or outer area of such district under the said Act, and in the manner

And whereas a petition, praying that the area described in the First Schedule hereto may be constituted an electric-power district under the said Act, and that the area described in the Second Schedule hereto may be constituted an outer area of such electric power district, was presented to the Governor-General on the seventeenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one:

And whereas such petition was publicly notified in the King Country Chronicle of the twelfth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, being a newspaper circulating

in the proposed electric-power district:

And whereas, after due inquiry, the Governor-General is of opinion that the petition should be granted:

Now, therefore, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursu-Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section three of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918, do hereby proclaim the district with the boundaries as-described in the First Schedule hereto to be an electric-power district, and I hereby assign to such district the name of the "Wairere Electric-power District": and I do hereby further proclaim that the outer area, with the boundaries as described in the Second Schedule hereto, shall be an outer area of such electric-power district. electric-power district.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

WAIRERE ELECTRIC-POWER DISTRICT.
