

such road to the junction of the last-mentioned road and the Tikitiki and Aramatai Roads; thence in a northerly direction along such last-mentioned road to a point where such road is intersected by the Mangapehi Stream; thence in an easterly direction along the southern boundaries of Blocks I and II, Mapara Survey District, to the Mokau River; thence along such river in a northerly direction to the south-eastern corner of Section 6, Block VIII, Otanake Survey District; thence along the eastern and northern boundaries of the last-mentioned section and the northern boundaries of Section 2, Block VII, Otanake Survey District, and Pukenui 2L 2 and Pukenui 2L 1 to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned block; thence along the western boundaries of Pukenui 2P 4 and Pukenui 2P 1 to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned block; thence along the south-western boundary of Pukenui 1B 7c to the northern corner of Maraetaua 2B 1; thence along the northern boundaries of Sections 16 and 1, Block VI, Otanake Survey District; thence along the western boundary of the last-mentioned section to the north-eastern corner of Kinohaku East 2 Section 24A; thence along the northern and western boundaries of the last-mentioned section to the commencing-point.

Also all that area in the Auckland Land District, being part of the said county, commencing at the most westerly corner of Kinohaku East 2 Section 20, and bounded by a line running westerly along the northern boundary of Kinohaku East 2 Section 15 to the Mangakowhai Stream; thence northerly to the south-western boundary of Kinohaku East 2 Section 28B 16B south to the north-eastern corner of Kinohaku East 2 Section 4B; thence by the northern and western boundaries of the last-mentioned block to the north-eastern corner of Section 3, Block VIII, Maungamangero Survey District; thence along the northern boundary of the last-mentioned section to the Mairoa Road; thence along such road in a northerly direction to the north-eastern corner of Section 5, Block VIII, Maungamangero Survey District; thence by the north-western boundary of the last-mentioned section to the most southerly corner of Section 6, Block VIII, Maungamangero Survey District; thence north-westerly to the north-western corner of Kinohaku West K No. 1; thence by the western boundary of the last-mentioned block to the north-eastern corner of Section 16, Block VIII, Maungamangero Survey District; thence in a westerly direction by the northern boundaries of the last-mentioned section and Section 17, Block VIII, Maungamangero Survey District, and Sections 11, 12, 13, 28, 27, and 26, Block VII, Maungamangero Survey District, to Mahoenui-Kawhia Road; thence along such road in a northerly direction to the eastern corner of Section 7, Block VII, Maungamangero Survey District; thence along the northern boundaries of Sections 8 and 19, Block VI, Maungamangero Survey District, to the Mangaohae River; thence along such river in a westerly direction to the most northerly corner of Lot 1 of Section 9, Block VI, Maungamangero Survey District; thence by the northern boundary of the last-mentioned section to the north-eastern corner of Section 10, Block VI, Maungamangero Survey District; thence by the north-western boundaries of the last-mentioned section to the Mangaotaki-Kiritihere Road; thence along such road in a westerly and southerly direction to the north-eastern corner of Section 11, Block VIII, Whareorino Survey District; thence in a southerly direction by the western boundaries of Sections 12 and 2, Block XIII, Whareorino Survey District, and Section 5, Block II, Awakino North Survey District, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence westerly by the northern boundary of Section 2, Block I, Awakino East Survey District; thence southerly by the western boundaries of the last-mentioned section and Section 1, Block II, Awakino North Survey District, to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned section; thence easterly along the southern boundary of the last-mentioned section to Section 5, Block V, Awakino East Survey District; thence in a southerly direction by the western boundaries of Sections 5 and 4, Block V, Awakino East Survey District, to the Awakino River; thence by that river in an easterly direction to the north-western corner of the last-mentioned section and the western and southern boundaries of that area of land containing three thousand and fourteen acres two roods sixteen perches (3,014 acres 2 roods 16 perches) called Crown land and situate in Block IX, Awakino East Survey District; thence along the south-western boundary of Mangaawakino No. 6 to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned block; thence in a southerly direction along the north-western boundary of Mangaawakino No. 3 to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned block; thence along the western and southern boundaries of the last-mentioned block to the southern corner of that piece of land containing one hundred and seventy-eight acres three roods thirty perches (178 acres 3 roods 30 perches) and marked Crown land; thence along the southern boundaries of

the last-mentioned section and Mangaawakino 2B to the Mokau River; thence in a northerly and an easterly direction along the boundary of the proposed Wairere Electric-power District to the commencing-point.

As the said areas are more particularly delineated on the aforesaid plan marked P.W.D. 56014, and thereon bordered black.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1908.
