WHEREAS it is provided by section two of the Public Works Amendment Act, 1910 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), that the Governor-General may, if he thinks fit, by Order in Council authorize the Minister of Public Works to construct, maintain, or control any water-race or watersupply works, either within or outside a mining district, which are proposed to be constructed or which have been

constructed out of funds provided by Parliament:
