

CITY OF AUCKLAND.

THE following resolution was passed at a meeting of the Auckland City Council held on the 29th day of November, 1923 :—

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows :—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £16,000, authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of the erection of library buildings, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fifth of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Auckland, comprising the whole of the said city; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-one years, or until the loan is fully paid off. 13

THE following resolution was passed at a meeting of the Auckland City Council held on the 29th day of November, 1923 :—

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows :—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £70,000, authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of tramways development, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven-eighths of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Auckland, comprising the whole of the said city; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-one years, or until the loan is fully paid off. 14

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £190,000 authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of street paving and improvement, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of twopence farthing in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Auckland, comprising the whole of the said city; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-one years, or until the loan is fully paid off. 15

THE following resolution was passed at a meeting of the Auckland City Council held on the 29th day of November, 1923 :—

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows :—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £40,000 authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of erecting workers' dwellings, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-eighths of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Auckland, comprising the whole of the said city; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan is fully paid off. 16
