ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and

sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby extend for a further period of six months the Order in Council dated the ninth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, and gazetted the eighteenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, prohibiting all alienation of the Native land specified in the Schedule hereto other than alienation in favour of the Crown.

THE HONOURABLE SIR FRANCIS BELL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section and by section one hundred and eleven of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1913 (as amended by section eight of the Native Land Amendment and Native Land Claims Adjustment Act, 1916), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby extend for a further period of eighteen months the Order in Council dated the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and gazetted the third day of August, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, prohibiting all alienation of the Native land specified in the Schedule hereto other than alienation in favour of the Crown.

THE HONOURABLE SIR FRANCIS BELL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby prohibit, for the period of one year from the date of this Order in Council, all alienation of the Native land specified in the Schedule hereto other than alienation in favour of the Crown.
