IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section three hundred and eighty-nine of the Native Land Act, 1909, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby lay out and take as a road the land described in the Schedule hereto.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the fifteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 78 of the twentieth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, taking land for a further portion of the Stratford-Kawakawa Railway, portion of Tahora Section, and for road-diversions in connection therewith, as affects the area of land described in the Schedule hereto, such portion of land being no longer required for the purposes for which it was taken.
