#### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 18th day of February, 1924.

THE HONOURABLE SIR FRANCIS BELL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by an Order in Council made under the Land Drainage Act, 1908, dated the twenty-third day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the second day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, the area described in the Schedule to the said Order in Council was constituted a drainage district under the said Act, to be called the Maungakawa Drainage District:

And whereas a petition, signed by a majority of the rate-payers in the said drainage district, has been presented to the Governor-General praying that the said district may be abolished:

And whereas it is expedient to give effect to the said petition:
