IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that the portion of road described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of this Order in Council, become a county road.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that portion of the Taringamotu Valley Road in the Auckland Land District, Taumarunui County, commencing at the northernmost corner of Section 10, Block XIII, Tuhua Survey District, and proceeding thence generally in a north-easterly direction adjoining or passing through Ohura South Blocks Part A No. 3E 2c 3B, Block XIII, Tuhua Survey District, A 3B 1, Blocks XIII and XIV, Tuhua Survey District, A 3B 2, A 3A, Block XIV, Tuhua Survey District, Part A 3E 2c 3B, Blocks X and XIV, Tuhua Survey District, and A 3E 2c 3A, Block X, Tuhua Survey District, and terminating at its junction with the Ngakonui Stream at a point in the said Section A 3E 2c 3A, being a distance of 3 miles, more or less. As the said portion of road is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 58745, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, in the Wellington Land District, and thereon coloured red.
