## A PROCLAMATION. WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the fifteenth day of

December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, and published in the New Zealand Gazette on the following day, the Town District of Kaikora North was duly con-stituted and proclaimed under the Town Districts Act, 1881, with the boundaries described in the Schedule to the said Proclamation:

And whereas by Proclamation under the Designation of Districts Act, 1908, the name of the Town District of Kaikora North was altered to Otane, to take effect on and after the first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and ten:

And whereas it is expedient to alter the boundaries of the said town district in the manner hereinster set forth.

the said town district in the manner hereinafter set forth:

Now, therefore, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe,
Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pur-Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in me by the Town Boards Act, 1908, do hereby alter the boundaries of the said Town District of Otane by excluding therefrom the area described in the First Schedule hereto, and do declare that as on and from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, the boundaries of the said town district shall be those described in the Second Schedule hereto.
