Gulf of St. Vincent, Port Adelaide.—Wonga Shoal Light (U).—*Intended Alteration in Period.*

Mariners and others are hereby notified that the period of the flashing white light (U) on Wonga Shoal will be altered on or about 1st March, 1924.

Position.—Lat. 34° 50' S., long. 138° 27' E. on Chart No. 2389.

Details.—The period of the flashing white light will be altered from three to seven and a half seconds, thus: Flash 1 sec., eclipse 6½ sec.
