ON the recommendation of the Native Land Purchase Board, referred to in section three hundred and sixty-three of the Native Land Act, 1909, and in exercise of the power in this behalf conferred upon him by that section, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby prohibit, for the period of one year from the date of this Order in Council, all alienation of the Native lands specified in the Schedule hereto other than alienation in favour of the Crown.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred by the Post and Telegraph Department Act, 1918 (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby amend, in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereto, the regulations for the classification and regulation of the Department made under the said Act and gazetted on the second day of July, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, as amended by Order in Council gazetted on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, insofar as they relate to the scales showing rates of salaries and increments of officers of the Department; and doth direct that this Order in Council shall take effect as from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four.
