FOXTON HARBOUR.—DREDGER OPERATING.

Marine Department,
Wellington, N.Z., 25th August, 1924.

THE Foxton Harbour Board notify that the Dredger "Hennessy" is now engaged in dredging operations in Manawatu River at a position almost opposite the jetty at Manawatu Heads, locally known as Fisherman's Flat.

The dredger, which will have moorings laid out to the north, north-east, south-east, south-west, and north-west, will probably remain in this locality for about six weeks, and between sunset and sunrise will exhibit white lights fore and aft, in all about four lights.

It is intended to dredge the channel to the eastward of the alignment of the jetty.

Care must be exercised by vessels when in the vicinity of the dredger.
