SCHEDULE.

RANGIORA RIDING.

ALL that area in the Canterbury Land District bounded on the north, east, and south-west respectively by the northern, eastern, and south-western boundaries of the Rangiora County as described in *Gazette*, 1917, page 4537, from the intersection of the centre of the River Ashley and the production of the western boundary of Section 11239, Block IV, Mairaki Survey District, to a point in line with the western boundary-line of Rural Section 3811, Block VIII, Mairaki Survey District; thence by a right line proceeding in a northerly direction to and along the western boundary of the vey District, and bounded as follows: Commencing at the
