BIRKENHEAD BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION striking special rate of fifteen-sixteenths of a penny as a security for loan of £17,000, authorized to be raised for the construction of streets and footpaths, passed at an ordinary meeting of the Birkenhead Borough Council held on 3rd December, 1924:—

RESOLUTION.

That, for the purpose of providing the interest and sinking fund on a loan of £17,000, authorized to be raised by the Birkenhead Borough Council under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for streets and footpaths construction and improvements, a poll for which was taken on the 12th day of March, 1924, the said Birkenhead Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 15/16ths of a penny in the £1 on the rateable value on all rateable property in the Borough of Birkenhead; and that special rate be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable annually on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and the amendments thereof, the Napier Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of two thousand one hundred and fifty pounds (£2,150), authorized to be raised by the said Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of erecting a "Mothers' Rest" building on that part of Clive Square lying between Emerson and Tennyson Streets and the cost of raising the loan, interest, and sinking fund for the first year and contingencies, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of eleven four-hundredths (11/400ths) of a penny in the pound on the unimproved value of all rateable property within the Borough of Napier; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
