SCHEDULE.

ALL that road in the Taranaki Land District, Ohura County, known as the Omaka Road (Aukopae Loan Block), commencing at its junction with the Wanganui River Road at a point near the south-western corner of Section 1, Block IV, Piopotea West Survey District, and proceeding thence generally in a south-easterly direction, adjoining or passing through the said Section 1 and Sections 3, 8, 9, part Section 7, and C.L. 11, Block IV, Piopotea West Survey District, and terminating at a point on the boundary between the said Section 9 and Section 10, Block IV, Piopotea West Survey District, being a distance of 1 mile 8 chains, more or less.
