Increasing Borrowing-powers of Wanganui Fire Board.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is provided by section thirty-nine of the Finance Act, 1920, as amended by section forty-two of the Finance Act, 1924 (hereinafter referred to as "the said sections"), that the Governor-General in Council may, on the application of any Fire Board established under the Fire Brigades Act, 1908, extend the powers of that Board to borrow moneys in excess of the limits fixed by section six of the Fire Brigades Amendment Act, 1908:

And whereas application has been made by the Board of the Wanganui Fire District for increase in the borrowing-powers of the said Board, as provided by the said sections, and it is desirable to grant such request:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by the said sections, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby declare that the powers of the said Wanganui Fire Board to borrow moneys in excess of the limits fixed by section six of the Fire Brigades Amendment Act, 1908, are hereby extended, but so as not to exceed the sum of thirty thousand pounds:

Provided that no moneys as aforesaid shall be borrowed, except subject to the provisions of the Fire Brigades Act, 1908, and its amendments.
