

*Amendment to the Regulations made by the Public Service Commissioner relating to the Examination of Draughtsmen of the Lands and Survey Department.*

IN pursuance and exercise of the authority conferred on him by the Public Service Act, 1912 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), the Commissioner, with the approval of the Governor-General in Council, doth hereby, in respect of the amended regulations relating to the examination of draughtsmen of the Lands and Survey Department, made on the eighth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the seventeenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, make the amendments shown in the Schedule hereto. Such amendments shall have effect from and after the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four.

SCHEDULE.

REGULATION 4 is hereby amended by striking out the figures "£300" whenever they occur, and substituting the figures "£335"; by striking out the figures "£180," and substituting the figures "£190"; by striking out the figures "£120," and substituting the figures "£135."
