RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Thames Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £575, authorized to be raised by the Thames Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of completing the undertaking

ONERAHI TOWN BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Onerahi Town Board hereby resolves as follows:—

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HOROWHENUA COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Counties Act, 1920, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Horowhenua County Council hereby resolves as follows:—
