

Notice to Mariners No. 50 of 1925.

NEW ZEALAND.—SOUTH ISLAND.—FOVEAUX STRAIT.—BLUFF HARBOUR.

*Berthing Beacons installed.*

THE Bluff Harbour Board notify that two pile beacons have been placed on the sandbank, which dries at low water, to the westward of the wharf.

The front beacon, white-painted, is situated 943 yards from the western end of the wharf, and the rear beacon, black-painted, is 200 yards westward of the front beacon.

These pile beacons have been placed so as to provide a transit line parallel to the wharf-face and distant 200 yards from it.

They are intended only for the purpose of facilitating the handling of ships at or near the wharf.

*Alteration to the Scale of Fares, Rates, and Charges in Force upon the New Zealand Government Railways.*

IN pursuance of all powers and authorities enabling me under the Government Railways Act, 1908, and its amendments, I, Joseph Gordon Coates, Minister of Railways, do hereby make the following alterations in the scale of fares, rates, and charges in force on the New Zealand Government railways open for traffic, as published in the *Gazette* of 12th December, 1912 (and amended from time to time), and I do hereby declare that such alterations shall come into force on the 22nd June, 1925, and that, unless otherwise provided, the charges herein prescribed shall in each case be increased by two fifths.

PART II.—LUGGAGE, PARCELS, HORSES, ETC.

PARCEL RATES.
