In pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in the Governor-General by the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1924, I. General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby abolish the existing registration districts known as the Tirau, Taupo, and Rotorua Districts, and do proclaim and declare that the territory heretofore comprised within the said districts is hereby divided anew into four registration districts, the names whereof shall be the Putaruru, Tirau, Rotorua, and Taupo Districts, and the boundaries whereof shall be conterminous with the boundaries of the marriage districts bearing the same names as are set forth in a Proclamation of even date herewith, made under the provisions of the Marriage Act, 1908.

WHEREAS it is provided by section three of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918, that any area or areas of land may be constituted an electric-power district under the said Act, and in the manner therein provided:

And whereas a petition praying that the area described in the First Schedule hereto may be constituted an electric-power district under the said Act was presented to the Governor-General on the second day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five:

And whereas such petition was publicly notified in the Golden Bay Times dated the sixth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, being a newspaper circulating in the proposed electric power district.

And whereas, after due inquiry, the Governor-General is of opinion that the petition should be granted subject to the proposed boundaries of the district being altered as hereinafter appears:

Now, therefore, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section three of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918, do hereby alter the proposed boundaries and proclaim the district with the altered boundaries as described in the Second Schedule hereto to be an electric-power district; and I hereby assign to such district the name of the "Golden Bay Electric-power District."
