Alterations to Scale of Charges in force upon the New Zealand Government Railways.

N pursuance of all powers and authorities enabling me under the Government Railways Act, 1908, and its amendments, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I, Joseph Gordon Coates, Minister of Railways, do hereby make the following alterations in the scale of charges in force on the New Zealand Government Railways open for traffic made on the 10th day of August, 1925, and published in the Gazette of 11th August, 1925:—

By adding Palmerston North to the list of stations in respect of which additional charges are to be made as provided in the following regulations:-

PART II.—LUGGAGE, PARCELS, HORSES, ETC.

Regulation 10 (paragraph 3). Regulation 21 (paragraph 2). Regulation 22 (paragraph 2).

PART III.—GOODS.

Regulation 15 (paragraph 2). Regulation 16 (paragraph 2).

By omitting from Regulation 13, Part II, the following:-

2. The terminal charge at Auckland, Frankton Junction, Hamilton, Wanganui, Wellington, Christchurch, Dunedin, or Invercargill specified in paragraph 3 of Regulation 10 will not apply to parcels forwarded under this regulation. Consignees must take delivery at destination station.
