BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the National-endowment land described in the Schedule hereto as a provisional State forest.

Revoking the Setting-apart of Land for Selection by Discharged Soldiers under Special Tenures, in the Wellington Land District.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation made on the twenty-second day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, and published in the *Gazette* of the twenty-fifth day of November then instant, setting apart settlement lands for selection by discharged soldiers, under the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, in so far as it relates to the land in the Schedule hereto.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, General Sir Charles Fergusson, Baronet, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto—and which was taken for a portion of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway (Taneatua Section), and which is no longer required for such purposes—shall, upon the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*, become a road, and that the said road shall be maintained by the Whakatane County Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land dealt with: 17-4 perches, being portion of railway land.
