WHEREAS a requisition in writing, signed by a majority of the occupiers of all the bakers' shops within the Borough of Waipukurau has been forwarded to me, desiring that all such shops within the said borough be closed in the evening of working-days as follows—On Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays at 6 p.m., and on Fridays at 8 p.m., with the following exceptions—(a) on the evening of the working-day next preceding Good Friday, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day, when there shall be no fixed closing-hour, and (b) on the evening of the working-day next preceding any of the other days mentioned in or coming within the meaning of section 26 of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22, when the closing-hour shall be 9 p.m.:

And whereas I, George James Anderson, Minister of Labour, am satisfied that the signatures to such requisition represent a majority of the occupiers of all the said shops within the said borough:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 32 of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22, I do hereby direct that on and after the 14th day of December, 1925, all the said shops within the said borough shall be closed accordingly.

The notice dated the 7th February, 1912, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 8th February, 1912, fixing the closing-hours of all the shops excepting hairdressers, tobacconists, fruiterers, confectioners, and restaurant-proprietors in the Town District of Waipukurau is superseded in so far as it relates to the shops affected by this notice, as from the date of coming into operation of this notice.
