RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Franklin County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling the Eketahuna County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of one thousand and fifty-three pounds (£1,053), authorized to be raised by the Eketahuna County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of reforming and metalling Benton's Road, the said Eketahuna County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one (1) penny and three-eighths (¾) of a penny in the pound sterling, on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the
